Supporting organizations include civil society organizations, networks, federations, academia, and governmental institutions.

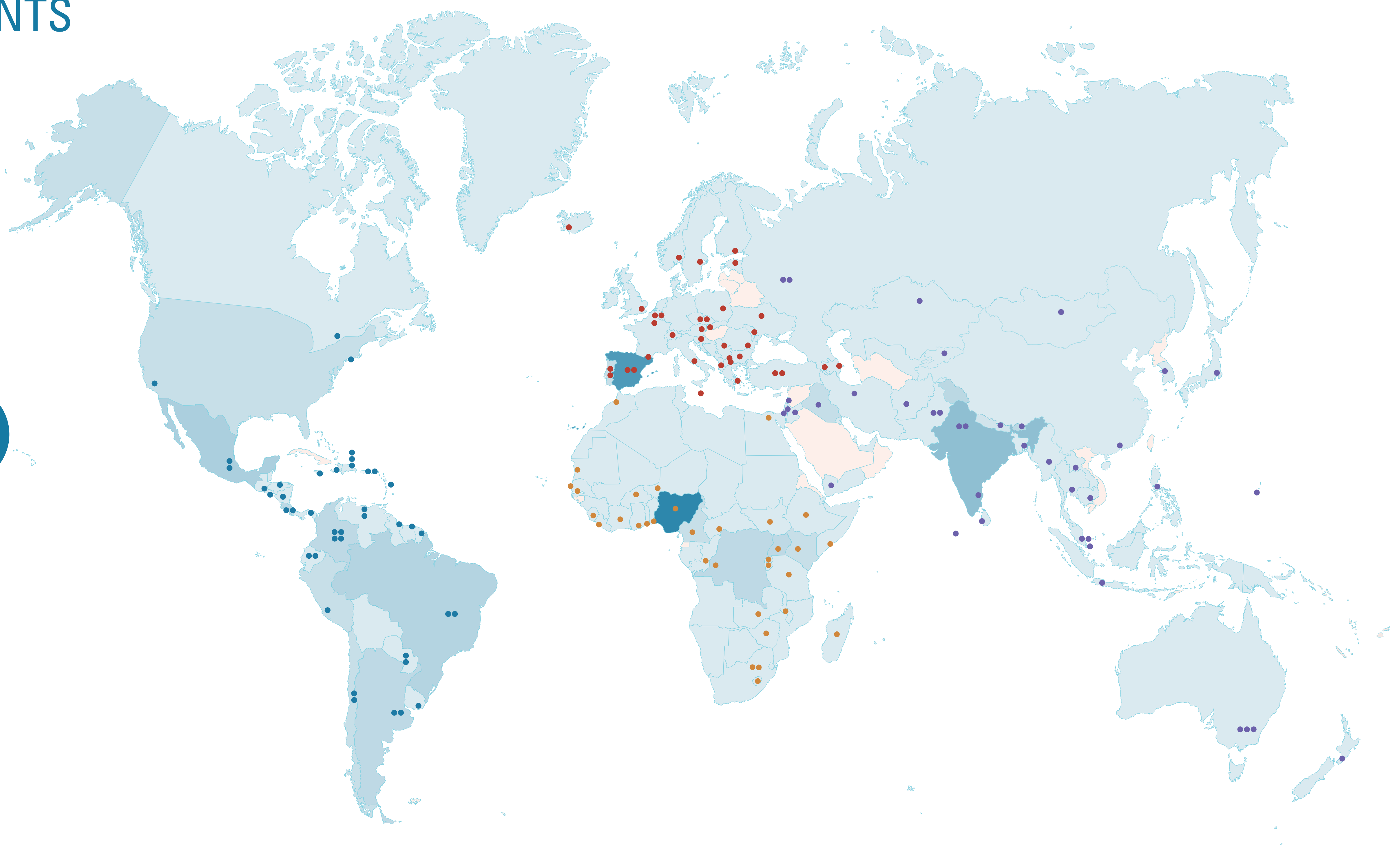
The focal points are reliable, expert professionals and organizations in the field of drug demand reduction internationally and locally.

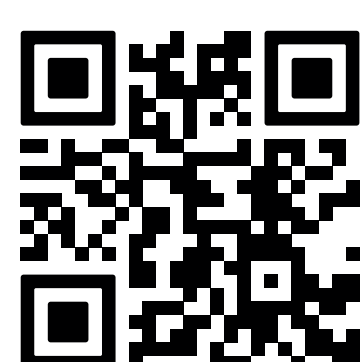
